The Bureau of Safe Drinking Water (Bureau) has reviewed your 2019 sample results for Perfluorononanoic Acid (PFNA) and, based on four (4) consecutive quarters of samples with no detections at all of point of entries, has determined that Lakeland Andover School qualifies for a reduction to annual monitoring, beginning in 2020.


If treatment for any perfluoroalkyl acids, whether regulated or unregulated, has been installed at any of entry point you must notify the Bureau as soon as possible, as quarterly monitoring is required as per NJAC 7:10-5.2(a)13.

Note that if the results of future sampling indicate any detections, sampling must return to the quarterly monitoring requirements at each applicable point of entry.

Monitoring results must be submitted electronically to the Bureau by the 10th day following the end of the month in which the sample was collected. **Please notify your laboratory of your reduced monitoring requirements.**

Asbestos Monitoring Waiver for the Nine-Year Compliance Cycle 2020-2028**

Dear Gary Defoe:

The Bureau of Safe Drinking Water is sending this letter to inform you of the Asbestos Monitoring Waiver determination for the 2020-2028 compliance period for the above referenced water system.

In accordance with the Federal Safe Drinking Water Act Regulations (40 CFR 141.23(b)), the Bureau is hereby granting this waiver based on the information in your Asbestos Monitoring Waiver application, which indicates that your water supply is not vulnerable to asbestos contamination either by its source water or by its distribution system components. This waiver is effective for the current nine-year compliance cycle: 2020-2028.

If our records are incorrect or if changes are made to your water system after the waiver is issued, and which may affect waiver eligibility (i.e. a new well was drilled in an asbestos vulnerable aquifer or if it has been determined that the distribution system contains asbestos cement piping or asbestos containing components), it is your responsibility to contact this office to have the records corrected. The Bureau will then re-evaluate your eligibility criteria and notify you of the waiver determination and/or monitoring requirements.
